<b>Right There</b> The answer is in the text. Look for words used in the question.	Why did the mother fox usually stay away from the farm?	She stayed away from the farm because she was afraid of humans.	The answer can be found in one sentence on the first page of the story.
	What did the farmer do right after he put the fire out?	He looked around for the fox.	On page 2, it tells me that he put out the fire and then on the next page it tells me he looked for the fox.
<b>Think &amp; Search</b> The answer is in the text, but I need to put it together using different pieces of information. Answer comes from different places in the text.	How did the fox and the farmer help each other?	The fox helped the farmer by howling at him and going back into the barn, which made him chase her. He found that his barn was on fire. The farmer helped the fox by letting her and her babies stay in the barn.	Information about the fox howling at the farmer is on page 2. On page 3 it tells me that the farmer found the fox, but walked away leaving her and her babies alone.
<b>Author &amp; You</b> Answer is not in the text. I need to think about what I already know, what the author tells me, and how it fits together.	Why did the farmer smile when he saw the fox and her kits in his den?	He knew why the fox had howled at him outside the barn, to protect her babies.	I used my own knowledge. The text doesn't say it, but the farmer knew why the mother howled at him, to help save her babies.
